

CHAPTER 3

CITIZEN COMMITTEES

3.005 Definitions. As used in BCC Chapter 3:

(1) "Committee" means any citizen committee, commission, or board to which appointments are made by the Board of Commissioners. [Ord. 85-0024]

3.105 Appointments.

(1) No Appointment shall be made to a committee position with a term expiring on December 31 of an even numbered year prior to a newly elected Commissioner assuming office during the next odd numbered year.

(2) Appointment to a position with a term expiring on June 30 of any year may be made anytime between February 1 and June 30 of the particular year.

(3) All other appointments may be made as vacancies occur. [Ord. 85-0024]

3.110 County Employes.

(1) No county employee shall serve as a voting member of a citizen committee that provides advice to the Board unless:

(a) The enabling act requires a specific county position to serve as a member of the committee; or

(b) The enabling act requires one or more committee members to possess certain professional qualifications which effectively require service by a county employe.

(2) Nothing in this section shall prohibit County employes from serving as ex-officio members, when so appointed by the Board. [Ord. 90-0067]

3.205 Term. The term or office for any committee position shall be as specified in the enabling legislation for the committee. Where no term is specified in the enabling legislation, the term or office shall be three years. [Ord. 85-0002]

3.305 Removal.

(1) The Board may remove any appointee for failure to attend three or more consecutive regular committee meetings.

(2) The Board may also remove any appointee for cause following public hearing, for reasons including, but not limited to:

- (a) Commission of a felony; corruptness;
- (b) Intentional violation of open meetings law;
- (c) Failure to declare conflict of interest;
- (d) Incompetence. [Ord. 85-0024]
