

## **RESERVOIR AVENUE REALIGNMENT**

**Description:** Realign Reservoir Avenue from SW 53<sup>rd</sup> Street to the western City Limits; Construct a three lane urban arterial street with two 12' travel lanes, 12' left center turn lane, 6' bike lanes, 8-12' planter strips, 5' sidewalks, curb and gutter, as well as storm water quality and quantity control structures. Install traffic signal at the new intersection of Reservoir Avenue and SW 53<sup>rd</sup> Street.

**Timeline:** Construction to occur Spring/Summer of 2011  
Estimated construction cost - \$1.5 million  
Funding Source – City System Development Charges, STP, Loan

**Status:** Plans and specifications are being produced to be put out to bid in March 2011.

**Background:** This project started as a joint effort between the private property owner and the County. Permits from the City of Corvallis, the Army Corps of Engineers, and the Division of State Lands were required prior to the start of construction. Preliminary grading and the associated wetland mitigation work have been completed.
