

What is the Dial-A-Bus Corvallis-Albany Service?

Dial-A-Bus, provider of wheelchair accessible, curb-to-curb transportation for seniors and persons with disabilities in Benton County, is now offering a route between Corvallis and Albany. The route operates two days a week, providing four round trips per day between Corvallis and Albany. The curb-to-curb service will get you from your location in one city to your destination in the other without transfers.

Who Can Ride?

- ★ **Senior citizens** 60 years of age and over
- ★ **People of all ages with disabilities** who are unable to access fixed-route bus service

This service is available through cooperation between Benton and Linn Counties.



How Do I Get a Ride?

Rides are provided first-come, first-served, on a reservation, shared-ride basis. You may request a ride 1-7 days in advance.

Consult the table below which lists the times Dial-A-Bus will be in Corvallis or Albany when planning your trip. When calling to schedule a ride, have ready **your appointment time**, the **exact address**, and **your return time**. Dial-A-Bus will call you to confirm your exact pick-up time the day prior to your trip.

If you need **wheelchair accommodations** or will be accompanied by an **attendant** or **companion**, please notify us when reserving your ride. Please also let us know if you will be connecting to another service, such as the Linn Shuttle or Amtrak.

Please note: Because of the limited capacity of the service, not all rides that are requested can be provided.

Service Area

The areas of service are within Corvallis city limits and within Albany city limits. Some locations en route between Corvallis and Albany, such as Tangent or Adair, will be served as time permits. Please call if you would like to schedule a ride to or from a location between Corvallis and Albany, and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Fares

\$3.00 per one-way ride. Exact fares are required. (Drivers do not carry change.)

Holiday Service Hours

The service does not operate on New Year's Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Weather Closures

During inclement weather, listen to local radio stations for information on closures.

Dial-A-Bus Etiquette

- ★ Be on time
- ★ No food, drinks, or smoking
- ★ Boisterous behavior is not permitted
- ★ Cancel if your plans change
- ★ Wear seat belts
- ★ Bring only belongings that you can carry, including items acquired on your trip
