

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


1. Benton County formally reaffirms the declaration of a state of emergency for Benton County, declared in Order No. D2020-042, and its extension in Order No. D2020-054 through midnight, October 31, 2020.
2. This order incorporates by reference Order Nos. D2020-042 and D2020-054.
3. This order urges and encourages residents, citizens, visitors and workers within the county to abide by the Governor's mandates relating to face coverings, hand sanitizing and washing, physical distancing and social gatherings.
4. This order further urges and encourages residents, citizens, visitors and workers within Benton County to limit outdoor social get-togethers to no more than 10 persons.




