Benton County Stormwater Program Construction Erosion Control and Long Term Runoff Management

Background

Federal/State stormwater program changes require Benton County to develop, implement, and enforce stormwater management programs connected to local building. This includes: **1) Unlawful Discharge Detection and Elimination (Illicit Discharge), 2) Construction Site Runoff Control, 3) Post-Construction Runoff Control (stormwater management).**

Current Erosion Control Program Status

Benton County will complete Construction Erosion Control and Long Term Runoff Management standards over the next 19 months.
