## **Paper**



Newspaper, inserts, magazines, catalogs and phone books



Non-foil wrapping paper



Advertising mail, envelopes, mixed paper



Corrugated cardboard (3'x3'x3' or smaller: please flatten)



Paperback Books Tip: donate to Goodwill or local senior center



Cereal and dry food boxes (remove liners).

#### **Plastic**



#5 plastic tubs (no lids)



Plastic bottles (no lids)



Plastic jugs



Pill bottles (non-prescription tubes)

#### Glass



Glass is no longer accepted in your recycling cart. Please bring it to the Corvallis Recycling Depot

## Metal (loose in bin/no bags)



Clean aluminum, aluminum tins & metal cans (empty, clean and dry)

## How to prepare your recyclables

- All containers, bottles, cans and jars should be empty, clean and dry
- · All recycling should go into the recycling container
- · No food waste, liquid or plastic bags
- Do **NOT** bag or box recyclables; leave loose
- All recyclables should be fit in your recycling container with the lid closed (if you have large cardboard, bring it to our Recycle Depot).
