Valley Landfills, Inc. submits the attached two copies of the July 2021 Semi-Annual 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart A Report for the Coffin Butte Landfill for your use and distribution. This report covers the reporting period of January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021. The Coffin Butte Landfill is subject to 40 CFR Part 63 AAAA and 40 CFR Part 60 Subparts WWW and A.

In accordance with 40 CFR §60.7(c), a semi-annual summary report, as provided in Figure 1 of 40 CFR §60.7, must be submitted to the regulatory authority within 30 days of the completion of the calendar half. An excess emissions and monitoring systems performance report, as described in 40 CFR §60.7(c), must also be submitted if the total duration of excess emission for the reporting period was 1% or greater of the total operating time, or if the continuous monitoring system downtime for the reporting period exceeded 5% of the total operating time for the reporting period.

There were no periods of excess emissions and the continuous monitoring system downtime was less than 5% of the total operating time during the reporting period; therefore, a summary report is the only required submittal.
