**Construction:**

- Preparing for rain, the ethylene propylene diene monomer (EPDM) cover that sheds water is completely done.
- Pushing forward with griffin material, similar to EPDM but a lighter material that can be reused.
- Down to a half-acre of exposed soil to manage, preventing an abundance of rainwater runoff.
- All vertical and horizontal wells have been completed in cell II, IV and V.

**Leachate:**

- Currently less than 700,000 gallons.
- A good estimate of leachate based on a half-acre of exposed soil estimates at 20,000 gallons.
- The goal is to keep leachate at the lowest levels possible.
