Harm Reduction helps people stay safe when they have sex or use drugs.

WHAT WE DO

- Street and community outreach in Benton County
- Help with OHP applications and enrollment
- Non-judgmental peer support and help accessing health and social services
- Education and rapid testing for HIV and Hepatitis C
- Referrals to services, treatment, and care for persons living with HIV and Hepatitis C
- Referrals for PrEP (Pre Exposure Prophylaxis) – a daily pill to help prevent HIV infection
- Referrals and transport to detox and residential treatment
- Referrals to MAT (Medication Assisted Treatment) / Suboxone
- Naloxone (Narcan) distribution to prevent overdose
- Anonymous syringe exchange
