## What is the Dial-A-Bus Corvallis-Albany Service?

Dial-A-Bus. provider wheelchair accessible, curb-tocurb transportation for seniors and persons with disabilities in Benton County, provides a route between Corvallis and Albany. The route operates three days a week, providing several round trips per service day between Corvallis and Albany. The curb-to-curb service will take you from your location in one city to your destination in the other without transfers.

#### Who Can Ride?

- Senior citizens 60 years of age and over
- People of all ages with disabilities who are unable to access fixed route bus service.

This service is available through cooperation between Benton and Linn Counties.

#### **How Do I Get a Ride?**

Rides are provided first-come, first-served, on a reservation, shared-ride basis. You may request a ride 1-7 days in advance.

Consult the table below for times Dial-A-Bus will be in Corvallis or Albany when planning your trip. When calling to schedule a ride, have ready **your appointment time**, **exact address**, and **your return time**.

If you need wheelchair accommodations or will be accompanied by an attendant or companion, please notify us when reserving your ride. Let us know if you will be connecting to another service, such as the Linn Shuttle or Amtrak.

Please note: Because of limited capacity of the service, not all rides can be accommodated.

#### **Service Area**

The service areas are within Corvallis and Albany city limits. Please call if you would like to schedule a ride to or from a location between Corvallis and Albany, and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Days and Hours of Service Monday, Wednesday, Friday 7:30am – 5:15pm

#### **Fares**

\$4.00 per one-way ride.

Clients are billed quarterly for rides.

#### **Holiday Service Hours**

The service is not available on: New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

#### **Weather Closures**
