

SW 53RD STREET GRIND AND INLAY



Description:

This project will grind the existing asphalt surface by 2-inches and replace it with new asphalt at the same depth from Harrison Blvd to Reservoir Avenue. The County will also improve traffic signal operation at the intersection of SW 53rd and Reservoir Avenue with the addition of another loop detector on SW 53rd Street. The County will also upgrade any ADA facilities that do not currently meet standards.

Timeline: Construction to occur Summer of 2020
Estimated construction cost - \$257,000
Funding Sources: CAMPO and County Road Funds

Status: **Contract has been awarded to Knife River.** Construction to commence soon.

Background:

This section of SW 53rd Street was initially constructed in 2005 as part of an urban upgrade which included a center turn lane and planted medians. This section of SW 53rd has seen unusual degradation and as such, a more pro-active approach to pavement maintenance is required. Through the Corvallis Area Metropolitan Planning Organization, the County was allocated funding to grind and inlay SW 53rd Street from Harrison Blvd to Reservoir Avenue.
