Deputy Brent Iverson's Memorial Service

On May 27, 2019, while driving home from a trip with his son, Deputy Brent Iverson suffered what is believed to be a fatal medical event and drove off of Fern Road, near Airport Avenue, in Benton County, the same jurisdiction that he has served for the past 11 years. His son was not injured.

Brent was a dedicated deputy and a great dad. He will be missed. He is survived by his two sons and a daughter.

Deputy Brent Iverson started his law enforcement career with the Oakridge Police Department in 2002. He transferred to the Junction City Police Department in 2005 and was eventually hired by the Benton County Sheriff's Office in 2008. During his time serving Benton County, Deputy Iverson worked as a patrol deputy and a Forest Patrol Deputy.

The Iverson family has requested the assistance of the Oregon Fallen Badge Foundation to assist in coordinating his memorial service. The service is scheduled for Friday, June 7, 2019 at the Suburban Christian Church at 2760 SW 53rd Street Corvallis Oregon. The doors open at 1:30 pm with the memorial service starting at 2:00 pm.

Prior to the service, Emergency Responders will conduct a vehicle procession escorting Deputy Brent Iverson and his family to the church.

Those agencies wishing to participate in the procession are to stage by 12:00 pm at 400 NE Circle Blvd, Corvallis Oregon.
